FA330 PAINTING with Acrylics and Oils

Supply List

ACRYLIC PAINT: Optional Colors:

- · Titanium White
- Cadmium Yellow Medium Cadmium Yellow Light
 - Naphthol Crimson Cadmium Red Light
 - Maganese Blue Mars Black
- French Ultramarine Blue (Red Shade) Cobalt Blue
 - Yellow Ochre
 - Burnt Sienna
- Look for the brands: Interactive, Golden, Liquitex (heavy body), because these paints have a better consistency and quality for painting. Also, most colors have the option of a "hue" instead of the real pigment. If you want to save money, buy the HUE of the Cadmiums...etc.

MEDIUM:

• Fluid Matte Medium (4-8oz) (I use Golden or Liquitex, but any brand should be fine).

BRUSHES:

- #2, 6# Bright Brush Sabeline
 - #2 Filbert Brush
 - #0 Round Brush
- Every brand has a different size for their Brights, Filberts,
 Rounds (type of brush). Buy about 3 brushes for the first class,
 and we will go from there. Please do not buy Bristol brushes.
 When in doubt, buy a package of a variety of sizes.

PALETTE:

 DISPOSABLE PALETTE. There are also other more expensive palettes called "Stay Wet," these palettes have a sponge that fits on the tray to keep the paints wet. Use purified water with these palettes since they mold easily.

GROUND:

- CANVAS BOARD (no larger than 11x14" because it may warp)
 - STRETCHED CANVAS
 - Buy an 8x10" or 9x12" for beginners.

PAPER TOWELS

PENCIL/ERASER/RULER

Small SPRAY BOTTLE (optional but helpful)

OIL PAINT:

- Titanium White
- Cadmium Yellow Light (or hansa yellow)
- Cadmium Red Medium or Light (or bright red)
 - Cobalt Blue
 - French Ultramarine Blue
 - Yellow Ochre
 - Burnt Sienna
 - Ivory Black
- Look for the brands: Winsor Newton (winton is ok),
 Grumbacher...If you buy a set, you might have to buy more
 colors later. If you already have paints, just bring what you
 have...I do have some colors available for a reasonable price if
 you are interested...just ask.

If you want to spend a lot of money you can also buy:

- · cadmium yellow medium or chrome yellow
 - cadmium yellow deep
 - permanent rose
 - cerulean blue
- permanent green light and much more in due time

BRUSHES:

- #2, 6# Bright Brush
 - #2 Filbert Brush

#0 Round Brush

• Every brand has a different size for their Brights, Filberts, Rounds (type of brush). Buy about 3 brushes for the first class, and we will go from there.


PALETTE:

 DISPOSABLE PALETTE. You will find this in the paper section (michaels/acmoore) If you are at Utrecht/Plaza look for 'gray matters."

GROUND:

- CANVAS BOARD (no larger than 11x14" because it may warp)
 - STRETCHED CANVAS
 Buy an 8x10" or 9x12" for beginners.
 - PAPER TOWELS
 - PENCIL/ERASER/RULER
- Turpenoid (buy a small BLUE container and bring a jar with a good lid)
