2024-2030- APS Strategic Plan Communications & Engagement Plan (DRAFT) May 2023 - June 2024

OVERVIEW: APS is beginning the process to develop the 2024-2030 Strategic Plan that will begin with a planning process in the Spring of 2023 and move into the development phase in the Fall 2023. The development process will occur throughout the 2023-24 school year.

Phase 1 - Planning (Spring 2023)

- Internal staff work
- A Steering Committee will be appointed

Phase 2- Development (Fall 2023 - Spring 2024) -

- Part I Strategic Plan Foundations: Mission, Vision, Core Values, Goals (Fall 2023)
 - Will result in recommendations to the School Board in December 2023
- Part 2 Strategic Plan Implementation & Monitoring Elements (Winter-Spring 2024)
 - Will result in recommendations to the School Board in June 2024

OBJECTIVES

- 1. **Process**—Raise awareness among internal and external stakeholders about the development process for the 2024-30 Strategic Plan, including timeline, and ways to participate in the process.
- 2. **Recommendations**—Share information, encourage engagement, and gather feedback on Steering Committee's recommendation to the Superintendent on the Strategic Plan Foundations (Mission, Vision, Core Values, and Goals) and later the Superintendent's proposed Implementation and Monitoring Elements.
- 3. Follow-up—Inform all APS stakeholders about decisions related to the 2024-2030 Strategic Plan (School Board adoption of the Strategic Plan Foundations in Dec. 2023 and the Implementation & Monitoring Elements in June 2024). Provide updates on the school divisions progress toward the goals and objectives in the 2024-2030 Strategic Plan.

STRATEGIES

- Provide information to internal and external stakeholders, including broader Arlington Community and be clear about the objectives, opportunities for input, and how input will be used.
- Position the Superintendent and Strategic Plan Steering Committee at the forefront of this initiative and provide opportunities for them to be visible in this process.
- Use appropriate APS communications channels to update and encourage engagement in process including School Talk and Engage Updates, social media, WhatsApp, Friday 5, Supt. weekly message and more.
- Use appropriate external communications channels to connect, update and encourage engagement with broader Arlington community through Social Media, Local Radio (WERA 96.7), ARL NOW, Gazette Leader, Chamber of Commerce, Arlington Economic Development, Inside Arlington County newsletters, Civic Federation Updates
- Share information internally (Friday RoundUp, LEAD session, Supt. Message, Staff Central, etc.) and solicit input from APS staff to build staff interest and investment in the development of the 2024-2030 Strategic Plan.
- Use targeted outreach to connect with under-represented community members through use of Social Media (WhatsApp), Bilingual Family Specialists, FACE action team coordinators (ATC), Weekly Spanish newsletter.
- Solicit stakeholder feedback through Steering Committee meetings, Engage website, Community Forums, Surveys and meetings with stakeholder groups.
- Offer virtual engagement opportunities.
