SOAR Analysis

WHAT IS A SOAR ANALYSIS?

A tool for organizing data to help with identifying an organization's strengths, aspirations, opportunities and results

Strengths

- What does the organization do well?
- A controllable element within the organization (i.e. graduation rates, standardized tests, etc.)

Opportunities

- What are the possibilities?
- A situation external to the organization that represents possibilities, innovations, positive direction for an organization to achieve its goals based on actions it takes (i.e. increased revenues, grants, research, etc.)

Aspirations

- What are our dreams or wishes?
- Linked to an organization's vision and strategic priorities

Results

- What are meaningful outcomes?
- What results would we need to see and by when to show if aspirations are achieved?
- Correlates with performance objectives in the current APS strategic plan

PURPOSE:

To help in the process of identifying key priority areas and strategic areas of focus in the Strategic Plan
