# **STUDENT TRANSFER REPORT 2016-2017**

This report provides information about student transfers within Arlington in school year 2016-2017. A transfer student is a student who attends a school but does not reside within that school's boundaries or one who attends a school that does not have an attendance area: that is, it is not a neighborhood school. The report informs the capacity monitoring and planning process. Factors which affect the number of transfers allowed are the previous September 30 membership and projected enrollment.

## **CONTENT OF REPORT**

All data included in this year's report reflect enrollment as of April 23, 2017. Only students in kindergarten through grade 12 are reported. It includes all students at countywide and area schools and out- of-county students attending through the non-resident staff tuition initiative.

The first table is a division summary at the school level of students who have transferred by sending school. For each school, it displays the total enrollment, the total number of students who transferred into that school, and the percentage of enrolled students who are transfers. It also provides a breakdown of the transfers by sending school.

Sending school, the school from which the student transferred, is usually the student's home school based on the address in the student information system. Under No Child Left Behind (NCLB), students who are scheduled to attend Title I schools that did not make Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) for 2 consecutive years could transfer to another designated school. The school that did not meet AYP qualified the student to transfer. In this case, the school from which the NCLB transfer was taken is reported here as the sending school. Note: This option ended with the reauthorization of the federal Elementary and Secondary Education Act in December 2015.

The second table is a division summary at the school level of students who have transferred by transfer type. For each school, it displays the total enrollment, the total number of students who transferred into that school, and the percentage of enrolled students who are transfers. It also provides a breakdown of the transfers by transfer type. Transfer types are defined on page 43.

A one page, school level summary for each school is included in this report. The school summaries are presented alphabetically in order of level: elementary, middle, and high.

Each school summary shows the distribution of students by three demographic characteristics: Grade, Race/Ethnicity, and Economic Status. There is a separate table for each characteristic of students who have transferred by transfer type. For each characteristic, the following are provided

- Total enrollment
- Total number of students who transferred into that school
- The percentage of enrolled students who are transfers
- The breakdown of the transfers by transfer type

<b>CS</b>	Crowded school. Any neighborhood elementary school that is not projected to reach 95% of its capacity within the next three years may exceed the five percent transfer limit, but only from schools at or projected to reach 95% of capacity within the next three years.
<b>CW</b>	To be used for countywide programs at ATS, Drew (Above kindergarten and excepting those for whom Drew is their home school), Jefferson IB, HBW, Kenmore, Gunston, Arlington Mill, Langston, all Stratford students AND schools with an extended attendance area (Barrett, Campbell). Except for Stratford, CW should not be used for countywide special education programs - use SE for these transfers.
<b>DH</b>	Hoffman-Boston only. Students in planning units 3610, 4817, or 4821 can attend either Drew or Hoffman-Boston, but the default school of residence in the Student Information System is Drew. This code denotes that Hoffman-Boston was selected.  <b>These students are not reported as transfers in the Transfer Report.</b>
<b>EA</b>	Students who have chosen to attend their new schools prior to the official implementation of the new elementary boundaries in 2015-16. Applicable to those Kindergarten through Grade 5 students that were reassigned to Ashlawn, Jamestown, McKinley and Nottingham elementary schools when Discovery elementary school opens in 2015-16 as part of the boundary decision by the School Board on May 16th, 2013. <b>These students are not reported as transfers in the Transfer Report.</b>
<b>ET</b>	Test Taker. Students who completed all of their course work but did not pass the required SOLs for graduation are entitled to return to any APS school to take an SOL test.  <b>These students are not reported as transfers in the Transfer Report.</b>
<b>FM</b>	Henry and Long Branch only. Arlington residents employed at Fort Myer are allowed to enroll their children at Henry and Long Branch. (Not to be used for residents of Fort Myer.)
<b>GF</b>	Boundary grandfathering: students remaining at school after boundaries changed, according to School Board-approved procedures. Not currently in use. <b>These students are not reported as transfers in the Transfer Report.</b>
<b>IB</b>	International Baccalaureate at Washington-Lee.
<b>IM</b>	Claremont, Key, Gunston, & Wakefield only. To be used for immersion (non-team) students at Key, all students at Claremont, and immersion students from outside of school boundaries at Gunston and Wakefield.
<b>KS</b>	Key and Science Focus (Science Focus only).

<b>MN</b>	Primary Montessori (Pre-K and kindergarten) students, Drew Montessori K-5, and Gunston Montessori 6-8 students from outside of school boundaries.
<b>OT</b>	Other transfers (e.g., living at shelter, homeless outside of Arlington, live at Fort Myer or by approval by Planning & Evaluation). * The home schools for students who live at Fort Myer are Long Branch, Jefferson, and Washington-Lee. Fort Myer is not included as an Arlington address in the Student Information System and so a transfer code of OT has to be entered for them. <b>These students are not reported as transfers in the Transfer Report because they attend their home schools.</b>
<b>PC</b>	Professional courtesy transfers for APS employees currently living in Arlington.
<b>RC</b>	Residence change. <u>Changing residence within Arlington:</u> High school students who have completed two or more years of their high school education in a particular high school at the time of the change of residence are entitled to complete their education in that high school. All other students who change residence during the school year may complete the year at the current school but must apply for a transfer to return the following year. <u>Changing residence outside of Arlington:</u> Please refer to policy 25-2.2 as this depends on the grade level and the time during the school year at which the change of residence occurs.
<b>RCHRD</b>	Residency change/hardship.
<b>RG</b>	Regular neighborhood school transfers requested by parents or guardians.
<b>SC</b>	Shared custody: used for students entitled to attend the school because of a shared custody agreement but living with a parent other than the one whose address is shown for registration. <b>These students are not reported as transfers in the Transfer Report.</b>
<b>SE</b>	Special education: used for students in countywide special education programs, dual enrollees who live outside of Arlington, or placement of special education students by IEP.
<b>SP</b>	The Assistant Superintendent of Administrative Services and/or Assistant Superintendent of Student Services or designee approves special placement for medical or psychological reasons or by request of local courts.
<b>SS</b>	Summer School only. Not valid for Barcroft Intersession. Required for every student attending Summer School at a school other than their school of residence. Barcroft should use the same code for Intersession as for the regular school year.
<b>SW</b>	Staff waiver transfers for APS employees who live outside of Arlington. Only for grandfathered staff waivers after 2014-15.
<b>TM</b>	Team transfer among team schools (ASF, Jamestown, Key, Taylor).
<b>TT</b>	Transfers from a Title I elementary school that did not make Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP). No longer a valid transfer type except for current students as of April 2014.
<b>VP</b>	VPI Pre-K students from outside of school boundaries. To be used for students who are 4 years old on entry to the program. <b>Pre-K students are not included in the Transfer Report.</b>
<b>XB</b>	Cross Boundary: students who have a mailing address other than Arlington but the deed/lease states that the dwelling is located in Arlington OR students who have the Arlington and neighboring jurisdiction boundary go through the dwelling entitling them to attend either school district. <b>These students are not reported as transfers in the Transfer Report.</b>
