






Using the letter scale A, B, C, D, or F, what overall grade would you give the performance of each of the following?






Black and Hispanic students generally score lower on standardized tests than White students. In your opinion, how important do you think it is to close this academic gap between these groups of students? (N=98)






Breakfast Program
