



Using the letter scale A, B, C, D, or F, what overall grade would you give the performance of each of the following?





To what extent are you satisfied with your ability to influence the policies that affect you? (N=82)




To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statement: My building is safe and secure. (N=82)








Quality of Instruction and Homework

How do you feel about the amount of time your students spend on homework? (N=82)








Class Size

How do you feel about the number of students in your classes? Would you say there are . . . (N=82)







Do you believe that the achievement gap can be narrowed substantially while maintaining high standards for all children? (N=82)


Is it the responsibility of the public schools to close the achievement gap between white students and black and Hispanic students? (N=82)






Academic Achievement Gap

How important is it to close the academic achievement gap between white students and black and Hispanic students? (N=81)






