### Must Dos

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ADA accessibility</li> <li>• Quiet spaces for study, help the introvert</li> <li>• Keep all Career Center programs</li> <li>• Marching band/music program</li> <li>• Space for pop-up restaurant</li> <li>• Shared parking solutions and underground deck</li> <li>• Swimming pool</li> <li>• Theatre</li> <li>• Fields</li> <li>• Parking</li> <li>• “Comprehensive” = same amenities as W&amp;L, Wakefield and Yorktown, including academics, athletics, drama, arts, music, parking and green space</li> <li>• Theatre</li> <li>• Practice Fields</li> <li>• Performance space</li> <li>• Adequate parking, not what the county thinks we can get by with</li> <li>• Bandrooms, choir rooms, art rooms</li> <li>• Theatre/auditorium</li> <li>• Multi-purpose fields/field house for: football, soccer, lacrosse, field hockey, ultimate frisbee, etc</li> <li>• Pool</li> <li>• Track (can be around fields)</li> <li>• Full-size gym (basketball, volleyball)</li> <li>• Be mixed use</li> <li>• Auditorium, lecture hall</li> <li>• Vision for one school vs. a bunch of special programs</li> <li>• Neighborhood school with a walking attendance zone</li> <li>• Shared facilities with community</li> <li>• Gym, Pool</li> <li>• Library</li> <li>• Performance space (flexible)</li> <li>• LEED Certification</li> <li>• Shared spaces with public</li> <li>• Community meeting space</li> <li>• Use all the spaces, don’t be locked in</li> <li>• Move ACHS to Arlington Mill Community Center</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Gym</li> <li>• Pool</li> <li>• Flexible green space arranged in pedestrian environment</li> <li>• No parking on-site</li> <li>• Comprehensive HS with all amenities of other schools</li> <li>• Columbia Pike Library, or fronting Columbia Pike if additional land is acquired</li> <li>• Gym</li> <li>• Net Zero</li> <li>• Theatre</li> <li>• ADA</li> <li>• Gym</li> <li>• Space for core, extra-curricular</li> <li>• Have good facilities for students for every sport offered at the other high schools—they need to be accessible without transportation issues</li> <li>• Move to other locations:</li> <li>• ACHS</li> <li>• Drew</li> <li>• PEP</li> <li>• HILT</li> <li>• Academic Academy</li> <li>• Public Library</li> <li>• Public library</li> <li>• Full support cafeteria</li> <li>• Outdoor lunch space</li> <li>• Off-site football and track</li> <li>• High school gymnasium</li> <li>• Multipurpose for large events</li> <li>• Be an economic transformer for Columbia Pike</li> <li>• Playing fields but not necessarily stadiums</li> <li>• NVCC classroom/presence/partnership</li> <li>• Partnership with Arlington Independent Media ??</li> <li>• Arlington Tech</li> <li>• Relationships with other entities to ensure access to fields for HS sports (ie Marymount lax field at Long Bridge Park)</li> <li>• Gym</li> <li>• Fully equipped gymnasium</li> <li>• Increase transit</li> <li>• Up to date ADA accessibility</li> </ul>
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## Should Dos:

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• LEED Certified</li><li>• Performing spaces, can be flexible with lecture hall</li><li>• Nice outdoor landscape for socialization</li><li>• Classrooms should have natural light whenever possible</li><li>• Carefully assess the Career Center programs and determine what can move (cosmetology, pilot school, HILT, etc)</li><li>• Have open design studio with flexible design stations and spaces for prototyping</li><li>• Access for all programs, connections</li><li>• Good community spaces (cafeteria, lounge study spaces)</li><li>• Think about whether Career Center programs all need to be under one roof or whether each high school can have some of these options</li><li>• Bikeshare</li><li>• Career planning/exploration/marketplace exhibition</li><li>• Agricultural roof (active, green/greenhouse)</li><li>• Natural light</li><li>• Physical connection across 9<sup>th</sup> street</li><li>• Cafeteria on top floor</li><li>• Bus stop kiosk on school grounds, safe for late students</li><li>• More natural light in classrooms (inside classrooms are dark/windowless)</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Incubation space/innovation labs</li><li>• Math labs, writing labs (existing classroom space)</li><li>• Flexible pop-up space</li><li>• Connect Garfield St. to 9<sup>th</sup> St.</li><li>• Greenspace/gardens</li><li>• Connect ECDC to a community/schools shared rec/library parking facility</li><li>• Pool</li><li>• Library</li><li>• Flex gym</li><li>• ECDC top floor offices</li><li>• Therapeutic pools for instruction and community use</li><li>• A space like the Thinkabit space at Virginia Tech in Falls Church</li><li>• Commercial kitchen that community can use</li><li>• Pool</li><li>• ECDC as partner. They own land. Parks and Rec builds facility/ECDC gets future office space as co-owner</li><li>• Underground parking</li><li>• Sports fields</li><li>• Include a NVCC building, joint use/shared use facility to offer 9-College hi-rise education</li></ul>
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## Could Dos:

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Move the library</li><li>• Satellite 1776 incubator location or partnership</li><li>• Vertical gardens to supply cafeteria</li><li>• Tennis courts</li><li>• Baseball field</li><li>• Elementary school does <u>not</u> need to be here and may detract from possibilities for secondary</li><li>• 9<sup>th</sup> Street flexible plaza (opens/closes, time of day/events)</li></ul>
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
