Five-year-old Montessori students are reported in Kindergarten. Career Center FTE are not included in the total as the students are already counted in their home school.

All Special Education students, including those in self-contained classes, all ESOL/HILT/HILTEX students, and all Transition Program students are included within the grade totals at each school.

Adult students are NOT included in the Pre-K through 12 projected enrollment. Adult students include special education or limited English proficient students age 22 and above or other students age 20 and above.

APS provides specialized services (i.e., Speech) to "dual-enrolled" students on a limited basis and invites PreK students to serve as "peer models" in PreK classrooms that are under-enrolled. Although both dual-enrolled and peer model students are counted towards total enrollment, they are not counted toward capacity utilization since they are in attendance in school only intermittently. The Fall projections are subject to program relocation decisions which will be reflected in the Spring update.
