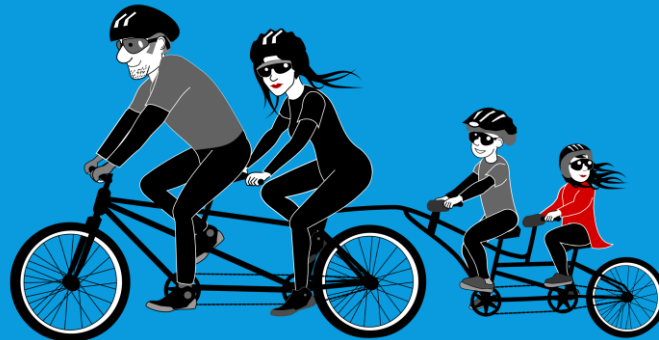

ENGAGEMENT APPROACH

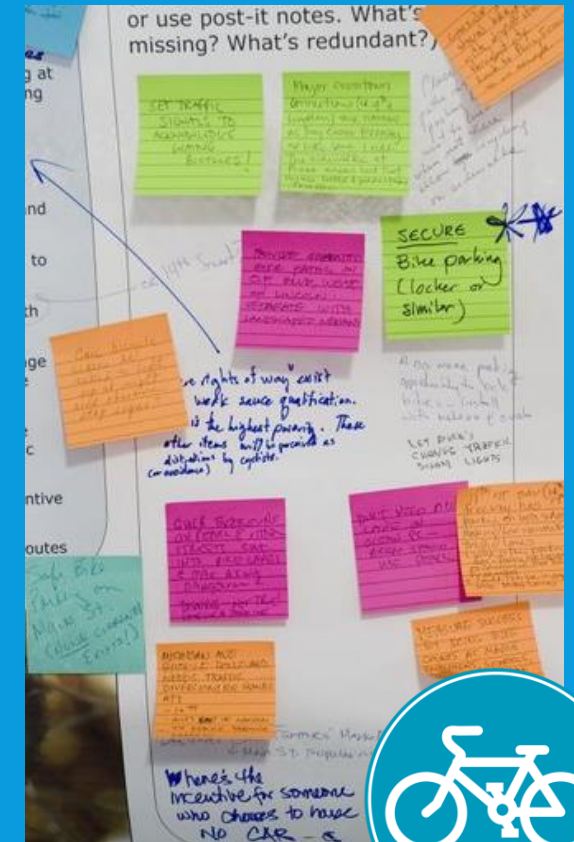
- In-person engagement at six scheduled pop-up events;
