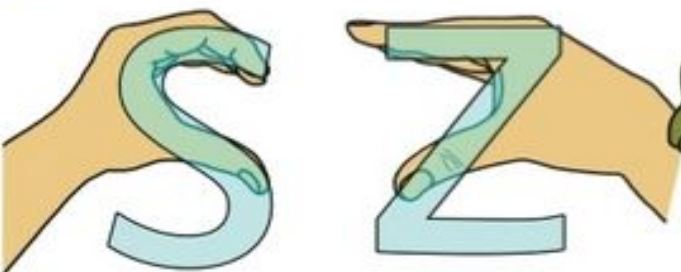
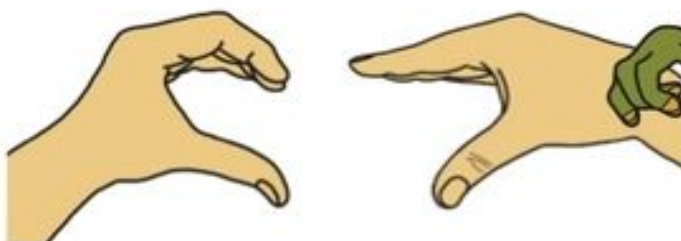
s and z
