## Virginia's Standards of Accreditation

- Overall proficiency and growth in English reading/writing, and progress of English learners toward English-language proficiency
- Overall proficiency and growth in Math
- Overall proficiency in Science

### **Achievement gaps**

English and Math achievement gaps among student groups

### **Student Engagement**

Chronic Absenteeism



### **Areas of Focus**

**Growth:** evaluating students based on how much they have progressed over a set amount of time

Engagement: level of involvement and commitment to school (Gallup, 2018)

**Proficiency:** a level of achievement that all students are expected to meet

Engagement	Graduation Rates		
Proficiency	CTE Credential Exams: industry credentials that verify students' mastery of industry specific skills  Phonological Awareness Literacy Screening (PALS): screening, diagnostic, and progress monitoring tool for measuring fundamental components of literacy		
	Social Studies Local Alternative Assessments: replaced SOLs in 2014		
	<b>Standards of Learning</b> : annual assessments of student achievement as a component of Virginia's accountability system

### **Performance Objective #1**

Increased achievement for all reporting groups on district and state assessments shows progress toward eliminating the opportunity gap.

- Overall, at least 90% of students will demonstrate proficiency on district and state assessments across all grade levels and content areas.
- Achievement gaps for all reporting groups will be reduced by at least 50%.
