The meeting was called to order at 2:02 PM.

The subcommittee discussed policy B-2.1.33 School Liaison and made edits to the policy, including renaming the policy “School Board Liaison.” It was agreed that the policy was ready to continue through the policy review process.

The subcommittee then reviewed the current draft of policy B-3.6.30 School Board Advisory Committees. Dr. Kanninen shared feedback from the Advisory Council on Instruction, and additional edits were suggested by the Board members. It was recommended that the current policies for individual advisory groups be converted to Policy Implementation Procedures (PIP) under this policy. Also suggested was creating a PIP for the Superintendent’s advisory committees. Ms. Goddard will update the draft to be shared with the other Board members and the chairs of the advisory groups for review and feedback.

The group then discussed the subcommittee meeting calendar and the schedule for reviewing the remaining policies. The group agreed that the Family and Community Engagement Policy should be moved to the Instruction section of the policy manual. Two additional meetings were scheduled.
