

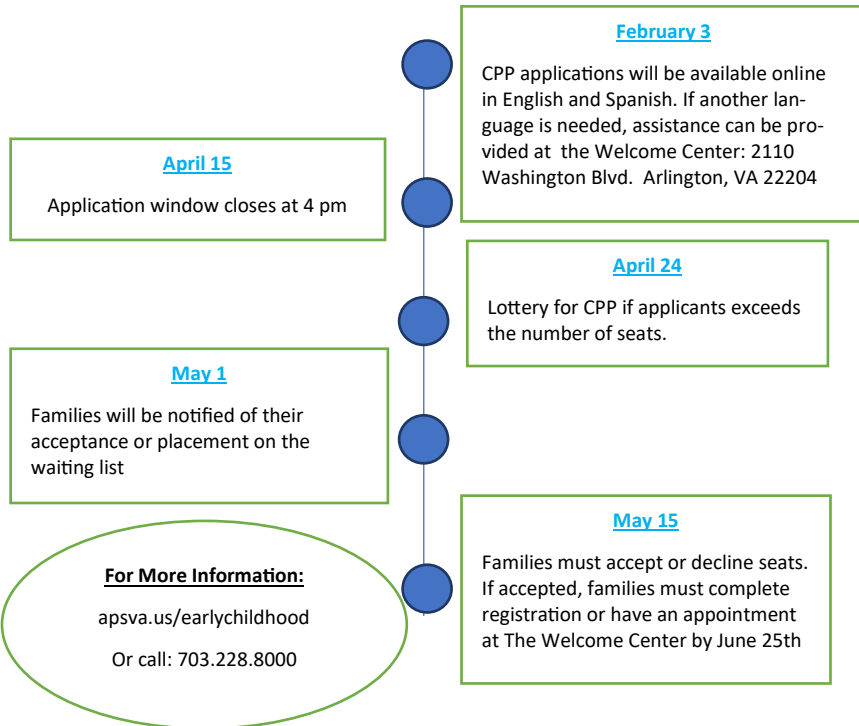


## ARLINGTON PUBLIC SCHOOLS

### Community Peer Pre-Kindergarten (CPP) Program

Arlington Public Schools (APS) meets the needs of 2-, 3-, and 4-year-old children with disabilities through Pre-Kindergarten Special Education services. Pre-k children without identified disabilities ages 2 years 6 months (by September 30), for toddler programs and 3 years 6 months through 4-years old, for 3-5 year old program have the opportunity to participate in one of the preschool Special Education Programs through the Community Peer Pre-Kindergarten Program (CPP). Priority consideration and enrollment in the program is given to neighborhood-zoned children, children in families below the 80% of the median income in Arlington (currently \$97,040.00 for a family of four in Arlington ) and children of current APS employees.
