We know students need to continue completing critical college, career, and life planning activities in Naviance, so we are committed to supporting you and your students without disruption.

In order to make the most of your student's time at home, Naviance has provided new resources to help students navigate the platform:

- ****NEW**** [Show Me How](#) is a self-service instructional tour designed to help students quickly understand the College Planning features in Naviance Student and reduce the support required from school and division staff. Staff can use Demo Naviance Student to use the Show Me How feature.
- Remember we can use Naviance to send you and your student e-mails. If you do not have your e-mail linked to Naviance, just log in and you can still access everything we have sent in your Naviance inbox.
- **Students currently have access to Naviance Curriculum Lessons until June 30th!** The curriculum offers 105 online, self-paced learning experiences related to college, career, and life readiness for students in grades 6 - 12. Lessons focus on six core themes:
 - *Self-discovery*
 - *Success Skills*
 - *Support Network*
 - *Career Planning*
 - *College Planning*
 - *Financial Planning*

Access to Naviance:

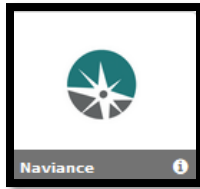
Students and Parents will be able to access their Naviance account using the My Access dashboard.

1. Log into their APS MyAccess dashboard.

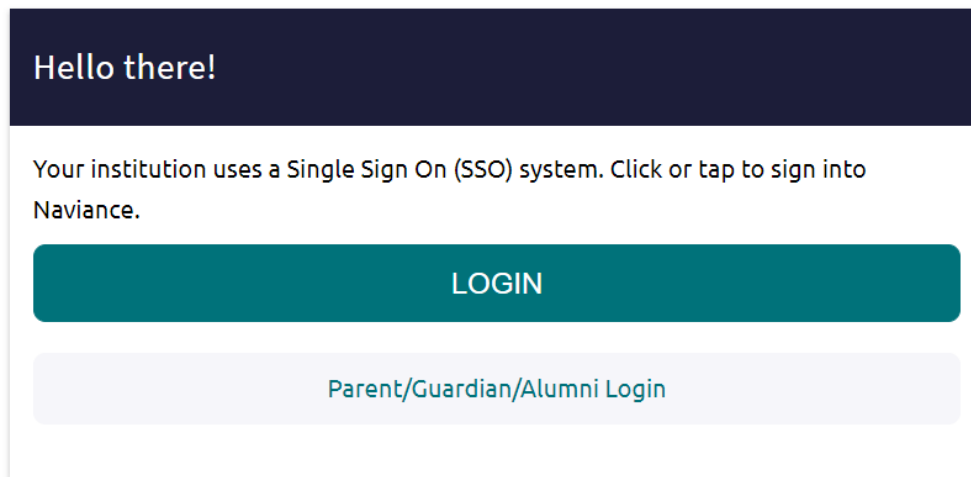


2. Click on the Naviance icon.
