Alternating Weeks (4 Days)

To reduce the number of students in school at the same time, instruction is rotated from in-person instruction to asynchronous distance learning. Cohorts of students would attend school for in-person instruction four days in one week, with one day for teacher planning and professional learning, and then rotate to asynchronous distance learning the following week. *In person and distance learning would be in all subjects (seven classes).* Participation in both core and electives/specials would occur as health and safety measures permit.

Alternating Weeks (4x4)

To reduce the number of students in school at the same time, instruction is rotated from in-person instruction to asynchronous distance learning. Cohorts of students would attend school for in-person instruction four days in one week, with one day for teacher planning and professional learning, and then rotate to asynchronous distance learning the following week. *Students would participate in concentrated blocks of four subjects for the first semester and four different subjects for the second semester.* Participation in both core and electives/specials would occur as health and safety measures permit.

Consecutive Days (2 Days/week)

To reduce the number of students in school at the same time, students would participate in two days per week of in-person instruction and three days of asynchronous distance learning. Final schedule may include block or seven period day. Participation in both core and electives/specials would occur as health and safety measures permit.
