

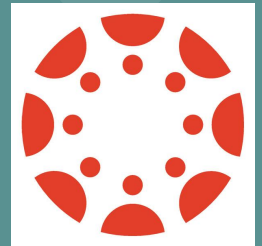

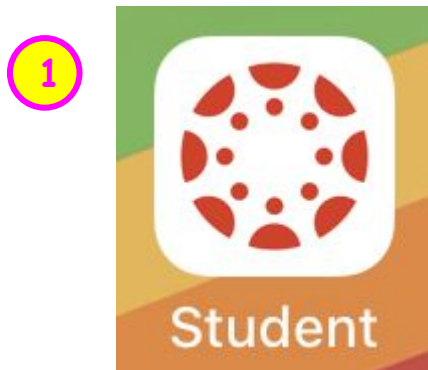

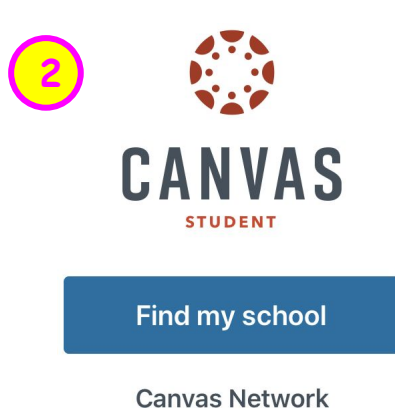

Logging in to the Canvas Student App

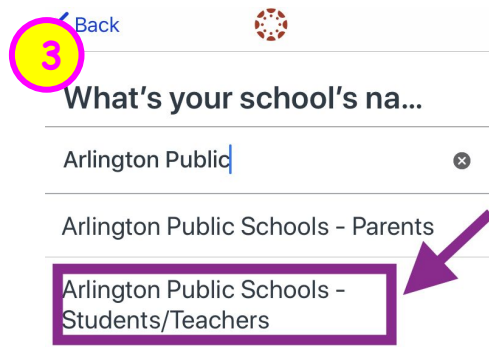
APS student iPads already have the Canvas Student App installed. This presentation shows how to login and use the Student Canvas App. Some students and teachers also like to access Canvas via the Safari browser on the iPad. 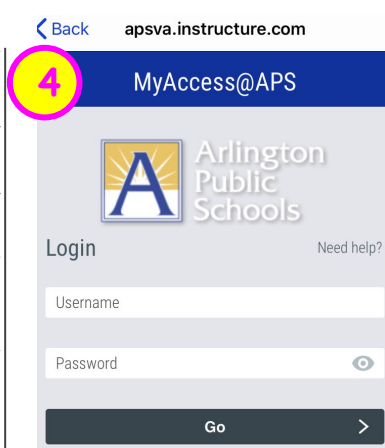
On the student iPad, locate the **Canvas Student App**. You can pull down from the Home Screen and search Canvas. Click on the App icon.



On this screen, click the **Find my school** button. NOTE: Do **not** type your School name.



In the "Find your school or district" field, start typing "**Arlington Public Schools**". Two options appear. Select the one for **Students/Teachers**.



On this screen, students enter their **Student ID** and **Password** and click the **Go** button.

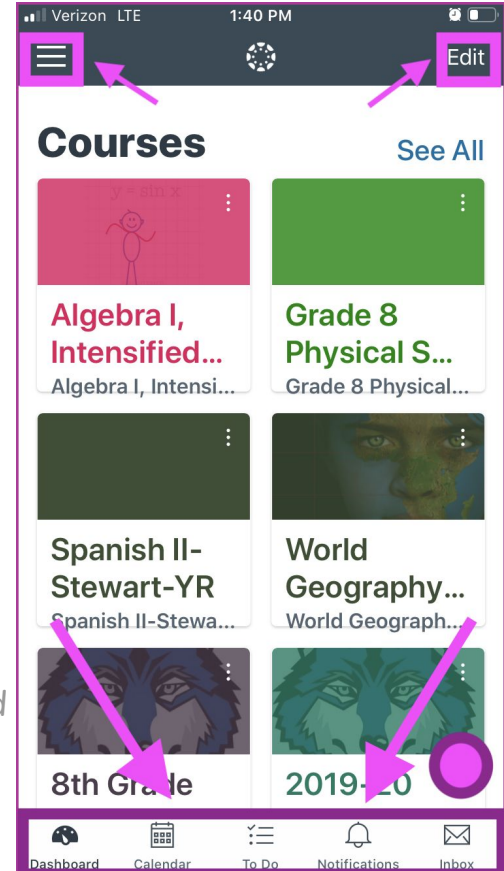

The app defaults to the **Dashboard** and displays your favorite courses. To open a course, tap the course name. Several APS teachers have a **Home Page** with links to Modules.

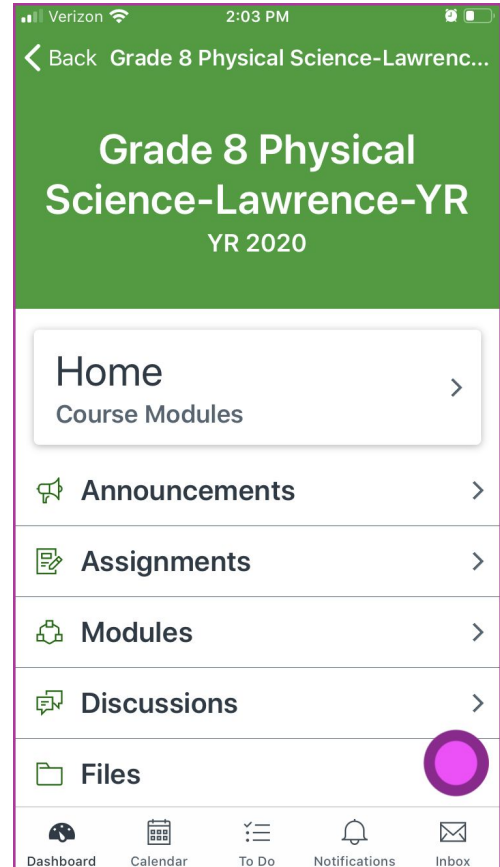

Accessibility Tools



There are various accessibility tools built into programs and devices.

Within Canvas

- [Accessibility within Canvas](#) (browser)
- Canvas Pages have [Immersive Reader](#) (*not in Announcements, Discussions, Assignments, Quizzes, etc*). We tested it in Safari on the iPad and it works in the browser (be sure to close the banner asking you to open the Canvas Student App in order to see the controls). Immersive Reader is not available on the Student App, but for read-aloud, students can use the built-in, text-to-speech iPad accessibility feature (Settings > Accessibility > Speech > turn on Speech Selection. Then select Text and choose Speak).
