Mid January - Mid February	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Judges evaluate student essays using the VDOE scoring rubrics Judges evaluate teacher narratives using the VDOE recommendation rubrics
Mid-February	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> APS Summer Residential Governor's School Committee meets to review multiple criteria and select nominees to send forward to VDOE
By February 26	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Gifted Services deadline to complete electronic nomination form and send applications to VDOE
Beginning of March	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> APS notifies students selected and not selected as nominees to send forward to VDOE based on state quota
End of April	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> VDOE notifies each nominee of admission status
