APS invites community members to review the data by planning unit for use in the Fall 2021 boundary adjustments for middle and high schools, as well as for Abingdon and Dr. Charles R. Drew elementary schools. Stakeholders can share input using an online community questionnaire, available next week in English and Spanish.

APS is seeking the following input from the community:

- Review planning unit data using the community's knowledge of their neighborhoods (Planning units are the geographic building blocks used to define attendance boundaries for neighborhood schools); and
- Provide input to staff about any data point(s) that need attention.
