### Supply List

Participants will need to procure art and creativity materials. While there is not a mandatory list of materials, here is a list of basic items that can be carried around easily.

- Color crayons
- Color pencils
- Color markers
- Watercolor palette
- Brushes of various sizes
- Container for water
- White paper (the thicker the better)
- Stickers, various
- Stack of color paper
- Some kind of fabric-like material, various colors
- Scissors
- Glue
- Tape (transparent and decorated)
- Decorative elements such as buttons, or gems
- Baby wipes for cleaning
- Paper towels for cleaning and drying

Acrylic colors are very helpful for creative expression but they are messy to use. Evaluate the need to use them according to the venue/ working space. Nowadays you can find some acrylic in the shape of sticks that dries very easily. There is also washable paint recommended when working in a not dedicated space.
