



Supply List: Watercolor Painting- Level 2 | FA251A

- Watercolor Brush: one #8 round red sable watercolor brush. You may also wish to purchase a synthetic or synthetic-blend brush. A #4 round brush and a 1-inch flat brush will come in handy for detail work and large washes. Many manufacturers have starter sets that contain very useful equivalents.
- Palette: Paper plates will work fine. Purchasing a paint palette is not necessary.
- Watercolor Paints: This product or equivalent will be good for class.

- Watercolor Paper: Any watercolor pad, block or loose paper with a weight of 140 lbs. (300gsm and 100% cotton) or higher.
- 2 Water containers: can use pint size cottage cheese
 - containers or similar size jar
- Pencil, Kneaded Eraser, Paper Towels, One roll toilet paper
- 1" wide masking tape or large metal clips to hold your paper down.
