

APS Test Administration 23-24

Students engaging in Home Instruction may participate in the test administrations scheduled at the school within their attendance boundary. Registration for the following assessments may be done through the counseling office of a student's school (as determined by attendance boundary):

- **PSAT/NMSQT (National Merit Scholarship Qualification Test)** (Grades 10 or 11): Registration must be done **no later than the second Wednesday of September** of each school year. Students being instructed while on Home Instruction may take the PSAT once through their home schools at no cost. Starting in Fall 2023, the PSAT/NMSQT will be administered digitally. Home instruction students who register for the PSAT/NMSQT will use an APS-issued laptop at the testing site.

Advanced Placement (AP): Registration must take place **no later than the second Friday of October** of each school year. Additionally, students may register for AP exams for a fee. *Financial aid is available based on evidence of need as determined by the standards for Free and Reduced Lunch. Registration for AP exams is now done online in the College Board site, and your child will need the code from the school to register for each exam they are taking.* In Spring 2024, select AP exams may be administered digitally. Home instruction students who register for the select AP digital exams will use an APS- issued laptop at the testing site.

- **PreACT:** Registration is encouraged as early as possible as the testing window runs the entire year. To test before the end of the current school year, registration must be done **no later than March 1**. Students may register for pre-ACT exams administered during the annual test window of September 1 - June 1 for a fee. *Financial aid is available based on evidence of need as determined by the standards for Free and Reduced Lunch.*
