

**The data on the following pages shows the inconclusive result of an anonymous survey to identify an alternative site to recommend for swing space, second to repurposing an existing elementary school.**

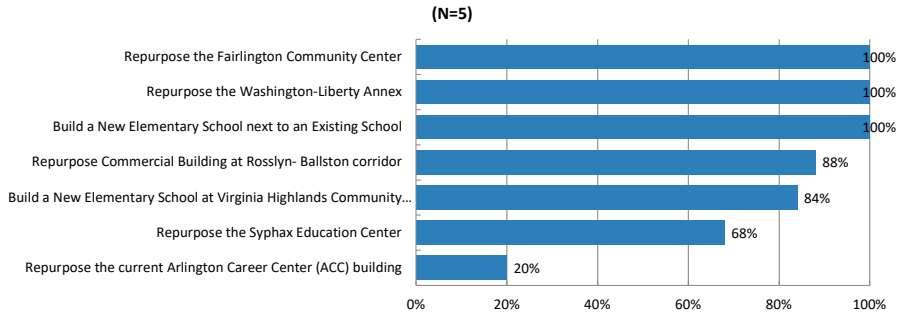
The team tasked to identify an elementary swing space location was composed of representatives from APS Departments of Facilities and Operations, Finance & Management Systems, Academics, School Support, and Diversity, Equity & Inclusion. After undergoing the four tasks outlined in Appendix J of the Pre-CIP report, the recommendation to repurpose an existing elementary school was unanimously agreed upon. No specific school was named.

An anonymous survey was sent to members of the team to help identify an alternative to recommend from the other potential swing space sites. Since this was being spearheaded by the Planning & Evaluation Department, no representative from that department submitted a response. As shown in these results, there was no best alternative based on those who responded. Therefore, all alternatives were published and presented in the Pre-CIP Report.

The staff recommendation will be to repurpose an existing elementary school with open capacity. All other options are alternatives for possible consideration.

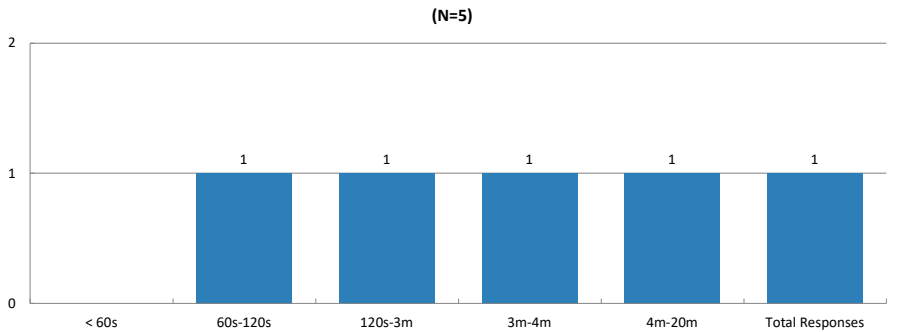

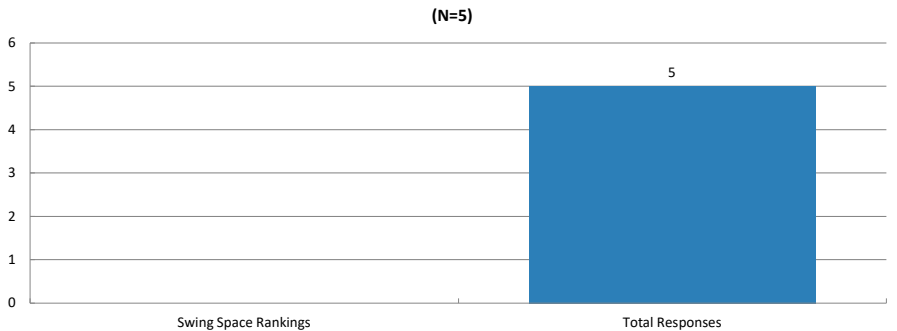

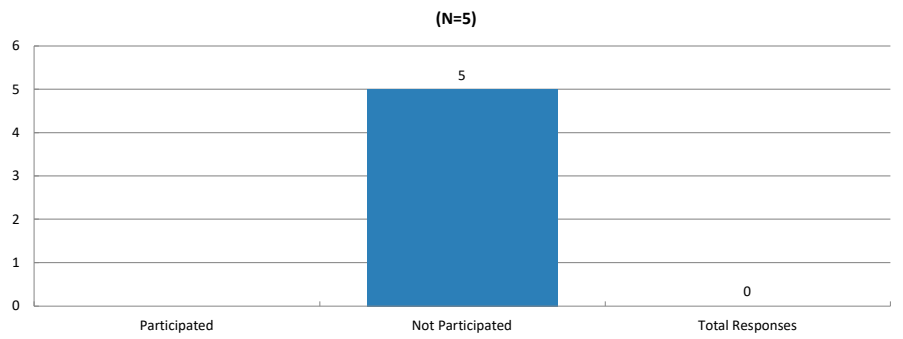

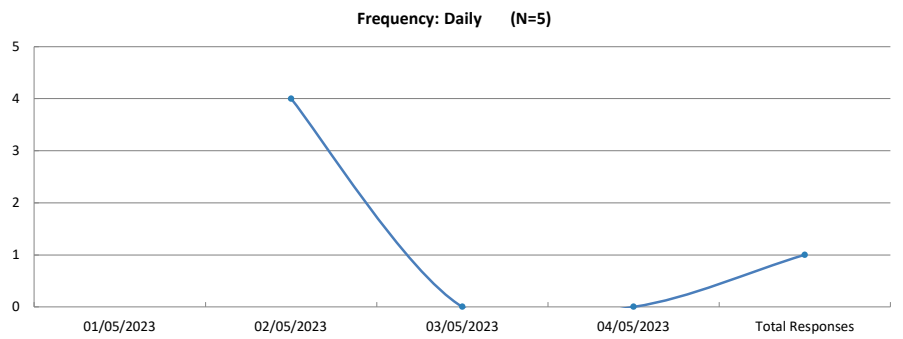
Channel by which participant accessed the survey
