



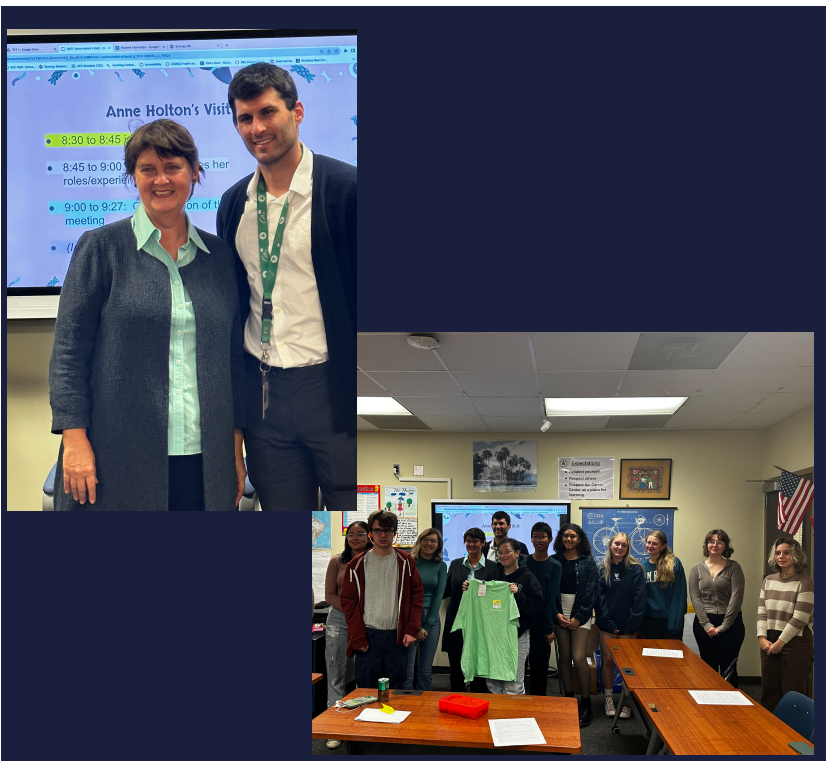
# Career and Technical Education

## Teachers for Tomorrow Special Guest Speaker

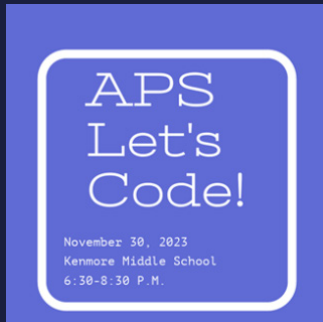
