## To register a student in Arlington Public Schools, parents/legal guardians must provide:

## 1. Proof of Arlington County Residency

If the student lives in a property that their parents/legal guardians own or rent:

ONE of the following documents must be provided:
$\square$ Deed showing that the student's parents or legal guardians own the property in Arlington.
$\square$ Current lease agreement signed by the lessor and lessee or tenant and landlord.

- Settlement documentation from a new home purchase if the deed has not been recorded.


## If the student and their parents/legal guardians live in the residence of someone else (shared housing):

THREE documents must be provided:
Form A - Parent/Legal Guardian Residency Affidavit
Form B - Statement of Arlington Resident Affidavit
$\square$ Leaseholder's current lease agreement or homeowner's deed or settlement documentation from a new home purchase if the deed has not been recorded.

## AND TWO DIFFERENT documents which support proof of Arlington County residency

 Two of the following supporting documents that include the parent's/legal guardian's name and current Arlington address must be submitted to the student's school within 30 days of enrollment date:Current Federal, state or property tax returns
Current Payroll or withholding statement

- 1 Current Utility bill (electric, gas, internet, water)

Financial assistance documentation from a U.S. government
Valid Virginia driver's license or ID
$\square$ Vehicle registration

## 2. Proof of Student Age and Legal Name

$\square$ Original birth certificate- If the original birth certificate is not in English, an official translation is required.
If the original birth certificate is not available, submit a Proof of Student Identity and Age Affidavit. The affidavit is valid for 30 days and requires additional supporting documents such as the child's passport.

## 3. Proof of Parent Identity and Relationship to Student

Any valid Government Issued Photo Identification (Driver's license or passport)

## 4. Documentation of previous educational program

## Not required to register, but if available submit:

Academic records or official transcripts. If these documents are not in English, official translations are required.
If applicable, submit Individualized Education Program (IEP), 504 Plan, English Learners records or Gifted records.

## 5. Health Records

Not required to register, but the following must be submitted to the student's school prior to attending:
Immunization Records (Grades Pre-K - 12)
Tuberculosis Test or Screening done within 12 months prior to starting school (Grades Pre-K - 12)
$\square$ Physical examination done within 12 months prior to starting school (Grades Pre-K - 5)
