I'm wishing everyone a happy summer!

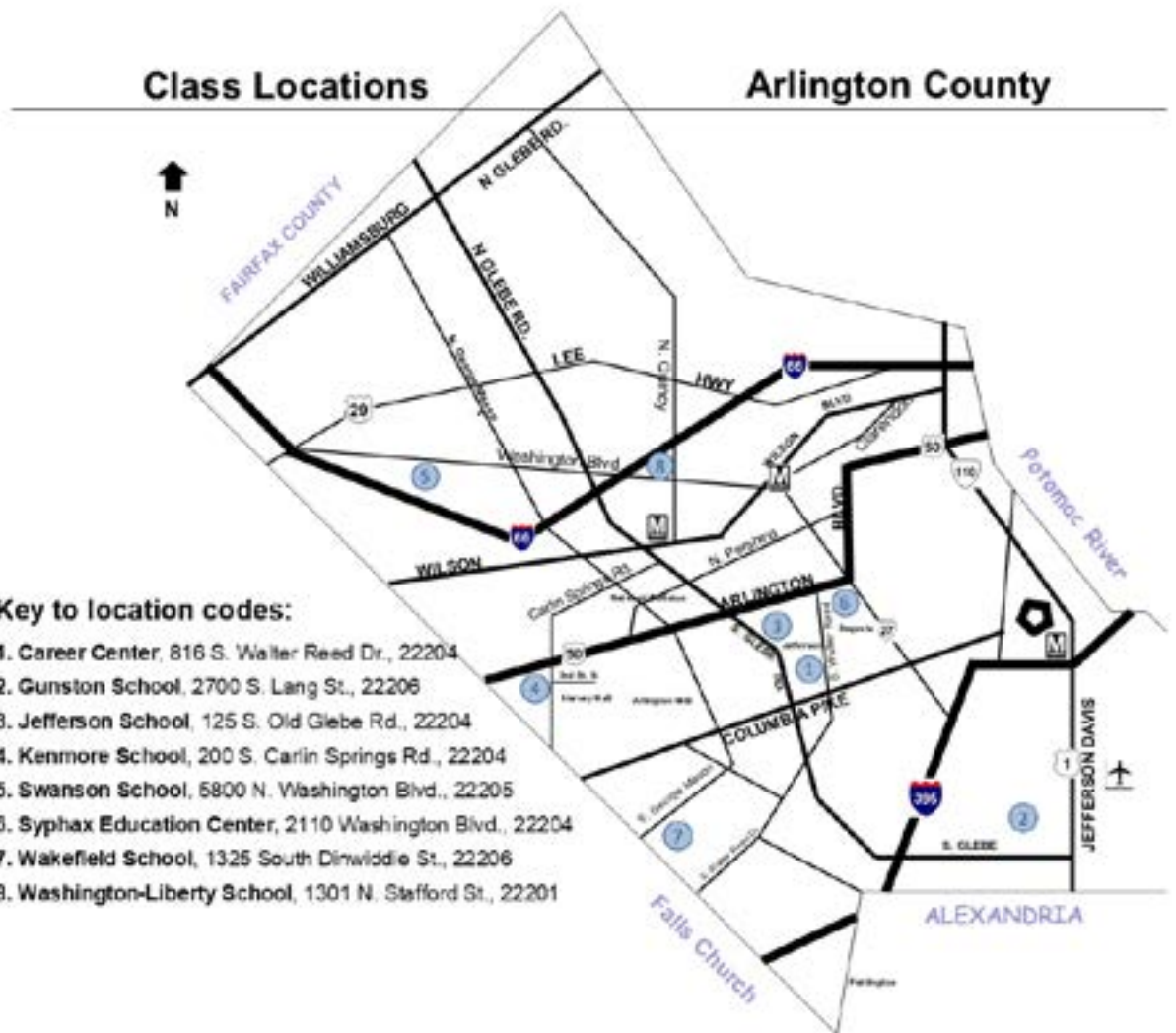

Just a Brief Introduction

No prior experience necessary. This class is designed to give students an introduction to the language. Students will learn common phrases, introductions, basic vocabulary and cultural aspects of the language.

Beginning - Level 1 Review

Prerequisite: Beginners 1 or equivalent knowledge. This course will review the information covered in our Beginning Level 1 class, which includes basic elements of grammar, vocabulary, oral skills, listening comprehension, and small amount of reading and writing.

Beginning - Level 2 Review

Prerequisite: Beginners 2 or equivalent knowledge. This class will review elements of grammar, building vocabulary, pronunciation, listening comprehension, and reading and writing covered in our Beginning Level 2 class.

Beginning - Level 3 Review

Prerequisite: Beginners 3 or equivalent knowledge. This class will review the grammar and vocabulary covered in our Beginning Level 3 class. Class focus on further developing conversation skills through oral and written exercises on a variety of topics.

Intermediate - Review

Prerequisite: Intermediate Levels or equivalent knowledge. This class will review the expanded vocabulary and grammar skills covered in our Intermediate level classes. More emphasis will be placed on conversation skills through oral and written exercises.

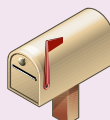
