Dear Parents/Guardians of Sixth, Seventh & Eighth Grade Students,

Your child is encouraged by their instrumental music teacher to audition for the Honors Band; this group is for the most able instrumental students in Arlington Public Schools. Students playing brass, woodwind, and percussion instruments are invited to audition. **Former members of the Honors Band are required to re-audition each year.** The director of the Honors Band is Randall Stewart and the Honors Band Manager is Kristen Bartholomew.

Auditions will be held **on Thursday, November 6, 2025, at Kenmore Middle School, 200 S. Carlin Springs Rd., Arlington, VA 22204**

- Check in for all students begins 15 minutes before your assigned audition slot. Registration times will be selected on the online registration form
- Audition slots are scheduled between 4:30 - 7:30 PM
- Students are free to leave once their audition is over
- All students will be notified of the results within two weeks by email

Students should prepare the audition music for his/her instrument ahead of time. The auditions will be blind - the student will not be seen by the adjudicators. Please register only if you intend to audition for the ensemble and participate in the event if selected.
