LEVEL	DESCRIPTION OF USE	STUDENT VOICE	EXAMPLES OF USE (STUDENTS & STAFF)
 Level 0 AI Awareness	Staff/students should not use AI tools on this task/assignment.	"Even though I am learning about AI, I'm not using it for this assignment."	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students complete a math worksheet without AI.• Teacher models how to evaluate sources without AI assistance.
 Level 1 AI-Assisted Idea Generation	Staff/students can use AI for guidance, like brainstorming or checking grammar. <i>No AI-generated content in the final submission.</i>	"I asked AI to help me get started or fix small things."	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Student asks AI to suggest synonyms for a poem.• Teacher uses AI to rephrase a rubric description.• Student checks grammar in a science report.
 Level 2 AI-Assisted Editing - Collaboration	Staff/students work with AI as a co-creator, coach, or thought partner, shaping/refining ideas together. Cite AI usage.	I worked with AI to build my ideas, but I made the final decisions."	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Student and AI co-develop a thesis statement for an essay.• Teacher uses AI to translate & adapt materials, then reviews for clarity & cultural relevance.• Student uses AI to brainstorm counterarguments in a debate.
 Level 3 AI Task Completion with Human Evaluation	AI plays a significant role in content creation, with staff/student oversight. Requires the critical engagement with the AI response. Cite AI usage.	"AI helped write or design parts of my work, but I reviewed & edited everything."	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Student uses AI to draft a lab report introduction, then revises.• Teacher uses AI to create a lesson plan outline, then customizes it.• Student generates a visual for a history project using AI.
 Level 4 Full AI Exploration	Staff/students experiment with AI as a "co-pilot" in innovative or advanced ways - redefinition of a task or assignment. Cite AI usage.	"I used AI in creative or technical ways to explore new possibilities."	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use AI to create a historical role-playing game. Analyze the results.• Teacher designs a project where students use AI to co-create virtual museum exhibits with interactive narratives.• Students create interactive stories using AI-generated images & text.
