Our holidays are diverse!



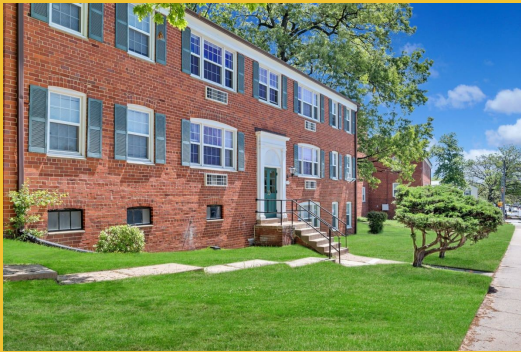
But many

Identity is what makes you, you!

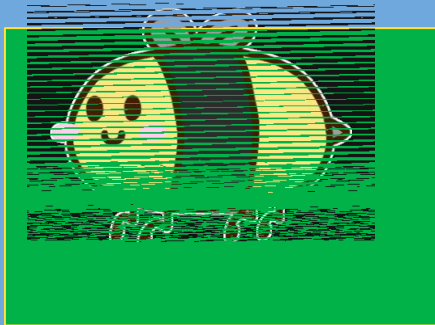


Let's hear about how others are special!
