



We believe cost should never stand in the way of participation. If you need financial assistance, please contact Raul at raul.matos@apsva.us for scholarship information.



Choose the Right Foreign Language Class

American Sign Language

Beginning 1

This class is designed for complete beginners and will focus on common greetings and phrases, pronunciation and simple vocabulary.

Beginning 2

Prerequisite: Beginning 1 or equivalent knowledge. Build your vocabulary and begin to focus on verb conjugation.

Beginning 3

Prerequisite: Beginning 2 or equivalent knowledge. Continue to expand your vocabulary and to focus on verb conjugation.

Beginning 4

Prerequisite: Beginning 3 or equivalent knowledge. Expand your vocabulary further and practice using present-tense verbs in longer, more detailed sentences.

Beginning 5

Prerequisite: Beginning 4 or equivalent knowledge. Strengthen your command of basic grammar and vocabulary while increasing confidence in everyday conversation.

Intermediate 1

Prerequisite: Beginning 5 or equivalent knowledge. Develop greater fluency by incorporating new tenses and more complex sentence structures.

Intermediate 2

Prerequisite: Intermediate 1 or equivalent knowledge. Broaden your conversational abilities while deepening your understanding of grammar and idiomatic expressions.

Intermediate 3

Prerequisite: Intermediate 2 or equivalent knowledge. Focus on refining comprehension skills and producing more natural, fluid speech in a variety of topics.

Intermediate 4

Prerequisite: Intermediate 3 or equivalent knowledge. Strengthen accuracy and nuance in spoken and written communication with increased grammar and vocabulary practice.

Intermediate 5

Prerequisite: Intermediate 4 or equivalent knowledge. Build confidence using complex grammar structures and engage in extended conversations with greater precision.

Advanced 1

Prerequisite: Intermediate 5 or equivalent knowledge. Enhance fluency and accuracy while exploring more sophisticated vocabulary and culturally rich topics.

Advanced 2

Prerequisite: Advanced 1 or equivalent knowledge. Improve expressive language skills through advanced readings, discussions, and targeted grammar refinement.

Advanced 3

Prerequisite: Advanced 2 or equivalent knowledge. Develop stylistic control, deepen cultural understanding, and strengthen advanced conversational proficiency.

REGISTRATION: Please register early to avoid disappointment. Tuition may be paid by check (returned checks are subject to a fee), money order, or credit card. We accept Visa, MasterCard and Discover Card. Make checks payable to: Arlington Public Schools. Registration is complete once payment is received. Cash payments are not accepted. **You will not receive confirmation**, unless you register online, in which you will receive an email confirmation. You must register before attending class. Instructor may not receive payment.

All Arlington resident students 62 years or older receive a discount on tuition, with some exceptions.

REFUND POLICY: You will receive a full refund if class is canceled by Adult Education. Refund requests received before the first class are subject to a 10% service charge (minimum \$10.00). Refund/transfers before the second class (of a multiple session course) are subject to a 10% service charge, plus a prorated fee for each class held before receipt of request whether or not the participant attended. No refund/transfers after second class. No refund for single night class if you were unable to attend. No refund on material fee if student cancels 48 hours prior to class.

WEATHER RELATED CLOSINGS: Adult Education classes are canceled whenever Arlington Public Schools close for inclement weather. Closings are announced on the Arlington Public Schools' website at www.apsva.us and local radio and TV stations.


